
Observation:

- Students agree on a curriculum that includes entrepreneurship and skill-based learning. Furthermore, the teachers believe that an updated syllabus for the students is critical.

















Observations:


- This form is to learn how the students are doing and how much the college has influenced them to have good knowledge and ethics in the workplace.

Alumni Feedback








Observation:
