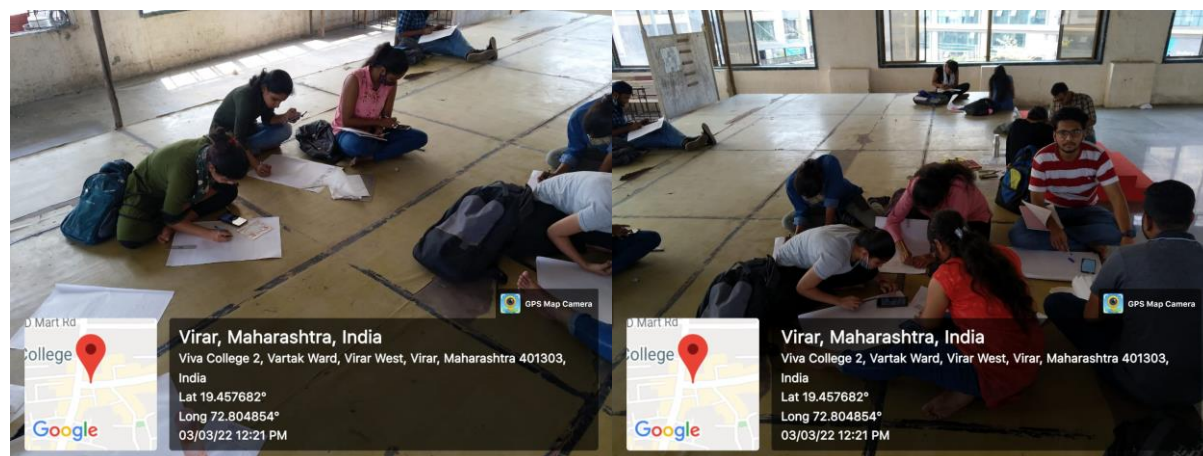
Poster making

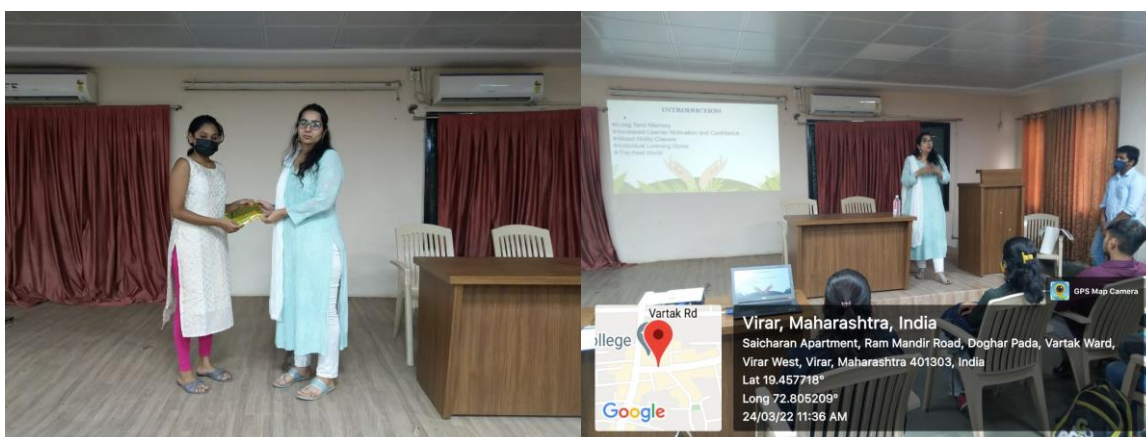
Second term training program

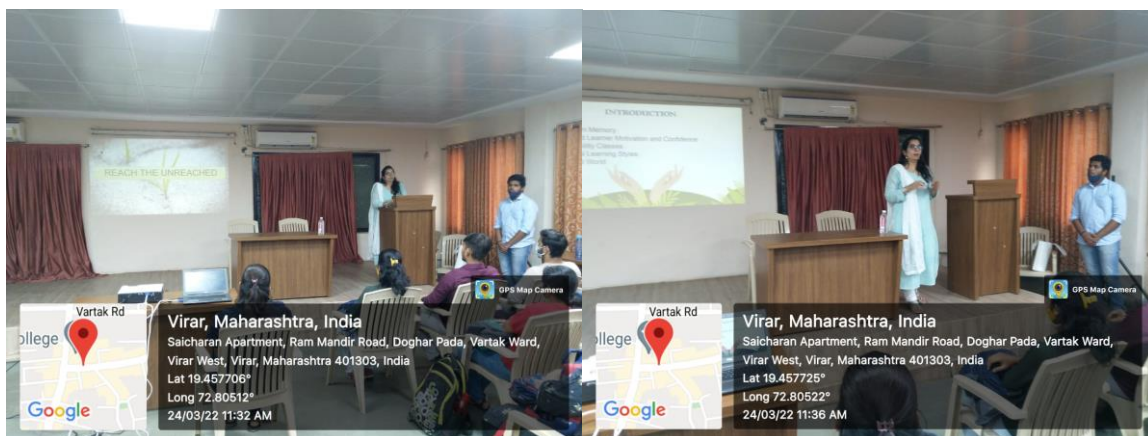
Date: 24th March, 2022 (Thursday)
